## The goals of the Governance Sub-Committee:

- 1. Ensure all Districts rules comply with the legal requirements of the Association Incorporation Reform Act 2012.
- 2. Ensure all the District's by-laws, policies and procedures are relevant and reflect the requirements of the Association Incorporation Reform Act 2012.
- 3. Governance Sub-Committee members to familiarize themselves with the Association Incorporation Reform Act 2012.

## **Action Plan:**

- 1. Consult with senior staff at Sports Focus to develop a strategy to get all Districts to update their Rules to ensure they comply with the legal requirements of the Association Incorporation Reform Act 2012.
- Request District Secretary's forward a copy of their current Rules/Constitution to the Secretary VVGA who will pass them onto the Chair of the Governance Sub-Committee.
- 3. If agreed, by senior staff at Sports Focus, develop a template of Rules for a District, which can then be distributed to all Districts (*at no cost to the Districts*') for them to insert their District's name and relevant specific details, then assist the districts' in lodging the Rules with The Dept of Consumer Affairs for registration and certification.
- 4. Encourage Districts to become members of Sports Focus (*a small annual fee applies*), to gain access to support regarding the Rules, compliance with the Act and information relating to amendments and updates to the Act.
- 5. The Governance Sub-Committee will also provide support to the Districts' in relation to all governance matters.
- 6. Upon completion of all Districts' Rules updates to achieve compliance with the Association Incorporation Reform Act 2012, the Governance Sub-Committee will seek to ensure the District's by-laws, policies and procedures are up-to-date and relevant.
- 7. Update and recommend any amendment to the Policies and Procedures of the VVGA Council, where necessary, to comply with the Association Incorporation Reform Act 2012
