Captains Report February, 2024

48BB Championship Buninyong. March 18th & 19th.

Planning has progressed well and the entry form and flyer have been posted on the web page and distributed to district Secretaries.

Greg Bennett, John Robertson and I attended a planning meeting at Buninyong in December with Nikki Prato and David Beggs. Procedures and formats for the event were discussed and locked in. Construction work on the clubhouse may not have started by the time that the event takes place so that should work in our favour.

The fairly mild summer sees the course in excellent condition for this time of the year.

Country Championships Riverside Mildura May 6th & 7th.

Mid-January, Treasurer Greg Bennett, myself and Western Zone Councillor Peter Irvin travelled to Mildura to meet at Riverside Golf Club to discuss the processes and logistics required to hold the Victorian Country Championships at that venue in May.

An extremely well attended meeting with Riverside delegates; Manager Brendan Bower, Lyn Thompson Treasurer, Peter Gourlay, Ned Klemm Sunraysia Captain, John Denman and Brian Young thrashed out details and clarified points of concern.

It is envisaged that an event flyer and application will be available for distribution in early March. The Monday evening dinner will be held at the Gateway Mildura.

The course has recovered well following the 2022 flood that completely inundated the course. The recovery is a credit to Greenskeeper Tim Peterson and the army of volunteers. While preferred lies are still in place on fairways, it is hoped that bare patches may significantly improve by May to allow for that local rule to be removed.

The following is an article that Brian Young had published in the Sunraysia Daily.

Members of the Victorian Veteran Golfers Association visited Riverside Golf Club to meet local veteran association members and club representatives. Greg Bennett (treasurer), Peter Irvin (zone councillor) and Peter Turner (Captain) travelled to Sunraysia last week. The purpose of their visit was to attend an event planning meeting to support locals to conduct a Victorian Veteran Golfers Association Statewide event at the course in May. Riverside was invited to host this contest last year and have readily agreed to hold the 36 Hole Championships (Stroke) and A,B and C Grades (Stableford) on Monday May 6th and Tuesday7th May.

A local committee consisting of Brendan Bower, Lyn Thompson, Peter Gourlay, Ned Klemm, John Denman and Brian Young held discussions with the VVGA team. Following the meeting the group spoke with greens keeper Tim Peterson and then the visitors familiarised themselves with the course by enjoying a game of golf. Veteran golfers from all over the state will be invited to join locals to compete in this two day event.

It is expected that a full field of 144 open to both men and women will tee off at the picturesque course over the two days. A shotgun starts each day with Nearest the Pin and best daily scores awarded to players. Visitors are invited to play on the Sunday prior to the championships and a dinner will be held on the Monday evening.

Registration will be available from mid-March on a first in first allocated basis. The event is open to all affiliated members of the VVGA and that includes all of the Sunraysia and District Veteran Golfers Association financial members. Players will have to have competed in two veteran events in the last twelve months and be fifty five or older. There are two local events scheduled before this day so you can make sure you meet all eligibility criteria by playing both.

Make sure you record these dates on your calendars so you don't miss out.

It's a great opportunity for Sunraysia to promote its golf courses and the district as a tourist destination. Many of our visitors will stay to enjoy an extended holiday. Locals also get to compete in a Statewide event without the normal travel commitments. Further information will be provided in our newsletters and our Sunraysia Daily sports reports so keep an eye out.



An issue that requires discussion is an historical requirement on the entry forms that to be eligible to enter, a golfer must be a financial member of a Veteran Golf Club and have participated in two district events. Who checks on this?

Vice President/Acting Councillors Report - Loddon

I answered queries and provided advice in relation to the VVGA model rules template to the President of the Corangamite District. The queries related to the adoption and lodgment process and the use of the common seal. Issues were resolved and model rules will be put forward for adoption at their AGM in late Feb 2024.

Acting as District Councillor I approached Bendigo GC and spoke with the Manager regarding hosting the VVGA Teams event in Sept 2024. He advised they would be happy to host.
